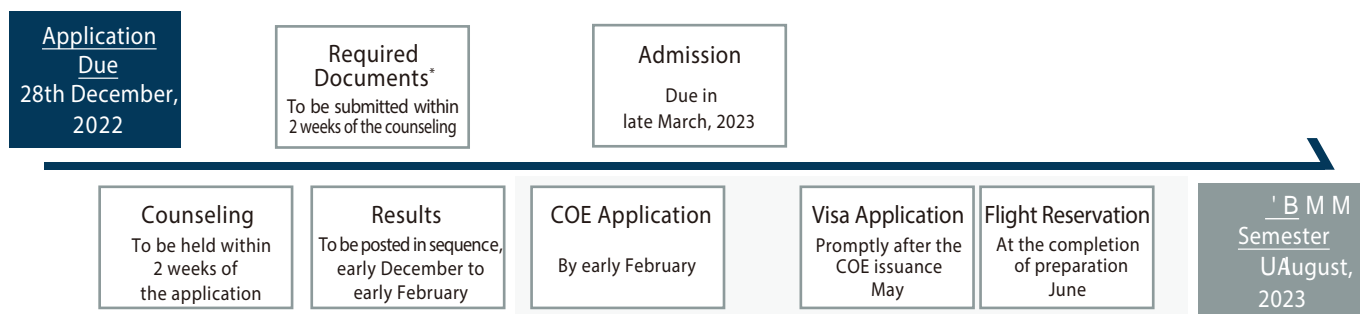


## ADMISSION TIMELINE



- \* Required documents for overseas high school graduates
- School transcript in English or IB score
  - English test scores (TOEFL 61 or IELTS 6.0 or above, taken within 2 years)

Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)

Score of at least 61 (iBT). ASU's institutional code is 4007. ASU accepts only electronic copies of the TOEFL score report.

International English Language Testing System (IELTS)

Overall band score of the academic test of at least 6.0. The general training exam is not accepted. No institutional code is needed.

However, if all the classes at your school are taught in English (other than foreign language classes), the above English proficiency test scores will be exempted, provided that a certificate issued by your international school is submitted. For the issuance of the certificate, please contact your school.

If not taught in English and you do not have or do not meet the English proficiency test scores listed above, you can meet the requirements by taking and completing the 8-week online English intensive program (ASU Global Launch: English for Undergraduate Admission and Achievement) at Arizona State University with a final score of 80 or higher.

## ADMISSION PROCEDURE



### For foreign students with no Japanese citizenship:

- Apply for a Certificate of Eligibility at your local immigration office as soon as your application is accepted.
- Apply for a student visa at a Japanese embassy or consulate in your region as soon as the Certificate of Eligibility is issued. More information on how to apply for a Certificate of Eligibility can be found on another document.
